

Registration policies

The following guidelines were voted on by the PCC Board of Directors:

1. All swimmers must be registered with USS. This non-refundable fee is collected in the fall for the coming year.
2. Online registration must be completed by posted registration date deadline. Failure to register forfeits your swimmers spot on the team. All open spots will be filled immediately from the wait list.
3. Swimmers must have approval from coach to register for their practice group.
4. There are no middle school discounts. PCC will not prorate for the short course session due to middle school swimming. No exceptions.
5. If a swimmer has an injury or health issue and has to leave the team, a doctor's note will be required for a refund. The board of directors will determine refund amount based on a pro-rated fee.
6. If a family is relocated out of the area, a request for refund can be submitted to the board for approval. The board of directors will determine refund amount based on a pro-rated fee.
7. All PCC families must work 2-3 sessions at our club sponsored meets. Families will be fined \$50 for each session missed.
8. **Racing Suits-** Swimmers in practice groups other than Senior Black and Senior Green do not need, and should not purchase "full body suits" or "tech suits" (ie. LZR racer or Pro's). PCC believes that the use of these suits is an advanced stage of athlete development and it is crucial for a swimmer to lay a strong technical, physical, and psychological foundation in the sport before moving to this equipment. Only athletes in the Senior Black or Senior Green groups should consider using "full body" or "tech suits" and then only in specific consultation with the coaching staff on the appropriate selection, meet, and proper use of the suits.
NOTE: USA Swimming passed legislation restricting the use of these suits for all age group swimmers beginning in May 2009. This restricts the type of suit allowed by USA Swimming rules for 12 and under age groups.
